
What can you expect on the day?

The Event Venue

#TogetherWithPride 2024 will take place this year at the prestigious 100 Wardour Street. Nestled in the heart of Soho, London, this incredible venue is close to a variety of public transport options, you can plan your journey on Google Maps here.
